## REFERENCES CITED FORMAT - APA 6th Edition



## **General Directions**

**APA** (American Psychological Association) style (6th edition) is *most commonly used* to cite sources within the sciences. A reference list is a <u>complete list of references</u> used in your research report. An APA reference list includes the **full references for all in-text citations used**.

Entries in a REFERENCE CITED section are alphabetized by the <u>last name of the author</u>: the date (of critical interest in science) is placed directly afterwards. An entry for which the author is unknown, such as a newspaper article or an unsigned review is alphabetized by the first word of the title, excluding the articles "a", "an," and "the." *Always double-space and <u>indent</u> the second and succeeding lines of each reference*. Do not number your references and if you have two or more references BY THE SAME AUTHOR, alphabetize them starting with the most recently written paper.

It is important to consult a VARIETY of sources when doing your research (more than just internet sources...)
